

# Ride4Hugo

4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> June 2022

## Terms and Conditions

The Terms and Conditions detailed below apply to all entrants participating in Ride4Hugo Prologue and/or Sportive. Completion of a Registration Form and payment of entry fees acknowledges acceptance of these Terms and Conditions by the participant.

1. All participants **MUST** wear a cycle helmet which conforms to CE standards EN1078.
2. Participants under the age of 16 years **MUST** be accompanied by an adult.
3. Closing date for entries will be Sunday 1st May 2021.
4. This event is not a race in any format and times will not be recorded.
5. Participants are fully responsible for their actions whilst attending the event. This includes before, during and after the challenge itself. RIDE4HUGO does not accept responsibility for the actions of participants nor the consequences of any such actions.
6. Participants are responsible for providing their own insurance to cover participation in this event. Payment of the Entry Fee does not include any insurance protection for accident, sickness or negligence of any individual participant. Any accident or injury caused by the rider's actions will be the full responsibility of said rider.
7. Places are transferrable up until 1<sup>st</sup> May 2021 then after places will be allocated to those held on the RIDE4HUGO reserve list. No refunds will be given, and places cannot be deferred.
8. Each participant will be fully responsible for any fees or costs incurred or arising from an accident either involving or caused by the rider. If the situation arises that you are not capable of making the decision to call the emergency services, the rider agrees that the organisers or a member of the public may call them. In this situation, the rider still accepts the costs and consequences of such action.
9. Each participant, upon completing the Registration process, agrees that they are physically and mentally capable of taking part. If there is any doubt, the participant should consult their GP.
10. Participants should display their issued event number on their person or clearly visible on their bikes.
11. Participants are strongly discouraged from using earphones (i.e. MP3, iPod, etc) on the grounds of safety.
12. Participants must register by 8am, allowing adequate time for the registration process, prior to commencing the challenge at their start time.
13. All participants agree to abide by the rules of the Highway Code, and follow the advice, direction and instruction of RIDE4HUGO employees, event volunteers and marshals to ensure a safe and successful event.
14. All participants **MUST** ensure that their bicycles are roadworthy, in good repair and suitable for use. Participants should ensure that bicycles are properly prepared and should ensure that a puncture repair kit and spare inner tube are carried as a minimum.
15. Participants are reminded that the event closes at **1700hrs**.
16. Participants may be refused the right of participation where the organiser believes the participant's safety and/or the safety of others, may be compromised.
17. Repairs carried out to participants bicycles prior to, during or after the event by the organiser or any of its agents or volunteers will be carried out at the participants own risk and RIDE4HUGO will not in any way be held responsible for any issues which may arise from these repair/s.

18. Should Ride4Hugo be cancelled or delayed due to unforeseen circumstances, RIDE4HUGO will endeavour to stage the challenge at a later date. In such a case RIDE4HUGO will endeavour to advise participants in writing, where possible. RIDE4HUGO's liability in respect of costs and expenses which participants may incur as a result of such cancellation or delay will amount to the sum paid for entry into the event only.
19. Participants **MUST** ensure that they sign in at the designated desk at the end of the challenge to enable RIDE4HUGO to ensure all participants have safely completed the route. Participants unable to do this for any reason should contact the communications number given at the start.
20. Participants raising sponsorship money are asked to ensure this is forwarded to RIDE4HUGO no later than **Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2021**.
21. Participants leaving parked vehicles should ensure that the appropriate parking fee is paid, or relevant permit is displayed. Any parking fines incurred are the responsibility of the participant.
22. Participants agree that images taken during the event may be used by RIDE4HUGO to promote the work of our charities and for advertising of future events.
